

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PLAYER RESPONSIBILITY FOR SCORECARDS

The Board of LMGA administers the "SKINS" game as a convenience to all our members. It is a time consuming process, we do not have the time or staff to correct incorrect score cards. We make our share of mistakes which are corrected as soon as we are made aware of them and can verify the error was the Board's. We rely on the score cards as submitted and per the Rules of Golf the player is responsible for the correctness of the scores entered for each hole.

For each game 2 cards are maintained. It is the responsibility of each player to verify their score for each hole on the card that is submitted to the pro shop. If both are submitted each player is responsible for assuring both cards are correct.

When a score as submitted is higher than the actual score for a given hole, the higher score is what is used for skins and the game. If a lower than actual score for a given hole is submitted, and the Board is made aware of the error, the player is disqualified.

SKINS GAME

For the 0-16 flight all birdies and better **MUST** be circled and each player is responsible for verifying that the score for each hole being submitted is correct. Incorrect scores and **NOT CIRCLED BIRDIES** (or better) will not be accepted for skins.

For 17-23 and 24+ each player is responsible for verifying the score is correct for each hole.

WEEKLY GAME

For the weekly game each player is responsible to verify his total score as well as his score for each hole is correct.
